### **REASON FOR THIS RECALL**

Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2006 Keystone RV Cougars. The fifth-wheels and travel trailers may have a deficient axle weld joint between the axle tube and spindle.

### **WHAT WE WILL DO**

The spindle will separate from the axle tube and the wheel and hub assembly will come off the vehicle which could result in a crash without prior warning. A notice has been sent to your selling dealership regarding this situation. The dealers stand ready to assist you in addressing this condition by replacing the axles.

### **WHAT YOU SHOULD DO**

At your earliest convenience, please make an appointment to have your fifth-wheel or travel trailer serviced by your dealership. The recreational vehicle will need to be at the dealer to perform this service correction approximately one (1) day. Please ask your dealer if you wish to know how much additional time will be needed to schedule and process your fifth-wheel or travel trailer.

Your Keystone RV dealer is best equipped to obtain parts and provide service to ensure your fifth-wheel or travel trailer is corrected as promptly as possible. If your dealer is unable to assist, please contact Keystone Customer Service by calling 1-866-425-4369. If you take your fifth-wheel or travel trailer to your dealer on the agreed service date, and the Dealer does not remedy the condition within a reasonable amount of time, or without charge to you, please contact Keystone Customer Service by calling 1-866-425-4369.
